## **Maintenance/Operation**

The Scooter racks are fixed items with no moving parts. After they have been fixed in position they are static and should not require maintenance as such. It is recommended there is a regular inspection to ensure that there are no damaged areas. If a Rack has been damaged that unit should be taken out of service and a new replacement fitted.

Minor repairs can be made to a small damaged section of the galvanising with a cold galvanising spray.

Floor mounted rack frames are secured to the end posts with appropriate bolts/nuts. The inspection should also include a check for any loose bolts. If any are found the unit should be taken out of service until replacement fixings are in place.

For Bolt-down surface installations and wall fix installations BASICS include Free of Charge proprietary masonry bolts. It is entirely the responsibility of the installing personnel to ensure the bolts are suitable for where the racks are being fixed.

During the regular inspection described above all ground bolts should be checked and if any loose bolts found the unit taken out of service until replacements fitted.

Floor mounted racks for concreting in below the ground have longer posts, these should be concreted in with a product appropriate to ground conditions. During the regular inspection the fixing should be checked if any rack is found to be loose the unit taken out of service until it can be re-fixed in position.
