Use

These gloves are designed and intended for protection from specific chemical hazards and are classified as **Complex design** (category III). Cleaning instructions

The washing and re-use of these gloves when used for chemical protection is not recommended. When used for cleaning and other non-chemical applications, gloves may be rinsed in cold water after use, wiped dry whilst still wearing and hung up to air dry.

Disposal

Dispose of these products in accordance with local regulations.


